GYMCAN NATIONAL TEAM EVENTS FOR 2020-2021

World Championships – World Cups – World Challenge Cups – Pan American Championships – Junior Pan American Games - Pacific Rim – Camps.

All other activities outside of Canada require a GYMCAN authorization form which can be found on the GYMCAN website (<http://gymcan.org/events-results/general-event-documents/authorization-forms>). Activities include, but are not limited to competitions, training camps, clinics, courses etc.

GYMCAN AUTHORIZATION TO HOST are required for all events that include international guests (guests defined as athletes, coaches, judges, choreographers, ballet master, et. al.).

FIG JUDGES

GYMCAN is responsible for arranging the travel for assigned judges to National Team events. Travel bookings are arranged to keep team members travelling together AND to support the trainings.

NON-NATIONAL TEAM ASSIGNMENTS

For non-National Team assignments, please refer to the GymCan Authorization to Travel form.

Directives for FIG Tournaments that are not NT assignments can be found on the FIG website (<http://www.fig-gymnastics.com/site/competition/search>). Gymnastics Canada has the responsibility of approving all GYMCAN authorization forms, assignments and completing the FIG registrations. If participation is limited GYMCAN will consider the most recent ranking list from either EC or CC. Highly recommended that an eligible judge be included on the form.

All communication with hosts for these events are done through GYMCAN, unless otherwise noted.

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. All participants are responsible for reading the Directives for the event they are attending. If you have questions contact torr@gymcan.org and bmosienko@gymcan.org
2. For all FIG Tournaments, judges are required to have a minimum brevet IV.
3. No assignments will be given or authorizations approved to any participant with outstanding invoices owing to GYMCAN



4. All self-funded expenses will be invoiced to the club of the athlete participating by GYM CAN prior to Nominative Registration and are payable by credit card or cheque prior to departure to the event.
5. Minors who travel without a parents/guardian are required to have a Travel Consent Form.
6. All FIG events are limited to NT members or potential NT members with Canadian citizenship that have been approved by the NTD or designate.
7. All gymnasts attending FIG events must be in possession of a FIG License. Note: Applications and renewals will be administrated by GYM CAN.
 - Gymnasts use the same FIG License card throughout their gymnastics career.
 - Renewals are done electronically by GYM CAN.
 - Approved Non- National Team athletes are responsible for the cost of their FIG license.
 - ALL gymnasts are responsible for lost card charges.
8. National Team members (athletes and coaches) are required to wear the current GYM CAN National Team uniform at official National Team assignments. For all other international events they are representing their club and therefore are to wear their club uniform.
9. National Team members (athletes) are required to wear their Venturelli technical training apparel at domestic and international events.
10. Risk Management Requirements for Coaches, Judges, Managers, IST: Police Record Check, Respect in Sport, True Sport Clean 101 and Making Headway
11. Starting January 2019, APPARATUS REQUIREMENTS BEGIN AT ALL FIG EVENTS (FIG & MANUFACTURER LOGOS)

Non-FIG invitations will be emailed to the PTO's.

PTO'S, NT Coaches & Brevet Judges are asked to email GYM CAN if you have any questions regarding National Team Events. All other questions should go through their PTO.

INTERNATIONAL VIRTUAL EVENTS

Virtual events will follow the same authorization to participate process as for in-person event. It is also recommended that clubs contact their provincial body regarding participation at international virtual events for sanctioning and insurance information. High Performance athletes are required to inform the NTD-RG of their participations at international virtual events should they choose to participate. Judges participating in international virtual events must inform GymCan of their participation as per the 2021 Judge Rules & Regulations.
