



## Outreach Facilitator

Rhythmic Gymnastics Manitoba is seeking a motivated individual who is passionate about the sport of rhythmic gymnastics to fulfill the position of Outreach Facilitator. This position will report to the Executive Director.

### Position Summary/Duties

- Promote the sport of rhythmic gymnastics and encourage membership at RGM member clubs.
- Facilitate gymnastics sessions as the lead instructor with developmentally appropriate programming for all ages and abilities.
- Create professional development opportunities for existing coaches.
- Lead gymnastics sessions and train teachers in how to host a gymnastics class in elementary schools throughout Manitoba.
- Assist Provincial Team Coach and RGM office staff with duties as assigned.
- Create new relationships within the community to host gymnastics sessions.
- Encourage current and former athletes to become involved as coaches and judges.
- Support RGM events such as the Manitoba Provincial Championships and Provincial Gymnaestrada.
- Create social media posts and content.
- Use computer applications and learn new software programs.

### Qualifications & Requirements

- NCCP Gymnastics Foundations Training.
- Class 5 Driver's License and access to a vehicle.
- Ability to do light manual labor (moving gymnastics equipment, setting up events).
- Must be able to work flexible hours, including occasional evening and weekends.
- Must have current Criminal Record and Child Abuse Registry check.
- CPR/First Aid.
- NCCP Competitive Stream training would be an asset.
